

Transcription video « For whom is autism online intended" Home page

Autisme en ligne is intended for professionals, including teachers of regular elementary school classes.

It is a self-study platform with free and open access, with videos of teaching practices and testimonies from professionals. It is the result of a collaboration between INSHEA and the Nouvelle École Farny in Geneva. It is a question of disseminating pedagogical and didactic know-how to promote inclusion of pupils with autism spectrum disorder, ASD.

The Autisme en ligne platform can also be a training tool for those accompanying autistic pupils as well as for parents. The content of this platform, in French and English, provides professionals and parents with pedagogical guidelines for working with pupils with ASD:

What type of interventions should be preferred?

How can the needs of pupils with ASD be met?

What pedagogical adaptations can be offered?

How to collaborate?

Different training modules summarise the main issues. Links to additional resources provide further information about the themes presented. A media library is available on the platform which includes the research work on which the training content is based as well as other tools and guides related to the themes addressed.
